RE: **2022 RELEASE OF CALIFORNIA DASHBOARD RESULTS**

PURPOSE:



























Review and understand the 2022 California Dashboard Accountability results.

BACKGROUND:

California's accountability reporting system is known as the California School Dashboard. The [Dashboard](#) is an online tool to help communities identify strengths and weaknesses and pinpoint student groups that may need support. In its sixth year, it reports status on multiple measures of academic and school climate. The Dashboard also focuses on the state priority of closing the performance differences among student groups' (e.g. race/ethnicity, socioeconomically disadvantaged, English learners [ELs]) performance. Based on results from the Dashboard, the CDE determines districts needing additional targeted support and improvement under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Piedmont continues to demonstrate excellence across multiple measures and was not identified as needing county or state interventions.

The Dashboard results are represented visually. In prior years, the Dashboard reported performance levels with color bands on a "gas gauge": red, orange, yellow, green and blue. Blue represented the highest performance level and red represented the lowest performance level. These performance levels were determined using two years of data utilizing current year status on the measure and the change over time from the prior year to show growth or decline. Due to the pandemic, the dashboard reporting mechanisms have been disrupted the last two years. The relaunched 2022 Dashboard will show *status only* measures rather than status and change over time and these results will be visually indicated by a "wifi bars" image. The more "wifi bars" the better the status outcome for 2022.
