

What is a SARC?

- A document that contains a wide variety of information about a school.
- State and Federal laws require all public schools receiving state and federal funding to prepare and distribute a School Accountability Report Card (SARC).
- SARCs are updated annually and published by February 1st.

What info does a SARC contain?

- Background information about the school and students:
 - Demographic information and enrollment numbers
 - School Climate
 - Academic Data
 - Class Sizes
 - Teacher and Staff information*
 - Curriculum and materials
 - Facility Conditions
 - Parental Involvement



Updating Process

Site and district leaders review and complete some sections

- Facility conditions
- Instructional Materials
- About the school, etc


The state populates some sections from data it has collected

- Academic testing data
- Teacher misassignments*
- Some financial data
- Class sizes



What's new and notable?

- Facility Inspection reports
- CAASPP results
- Physical Fitness Test results are participation rates only
- 2021–22 data for Teacher Preparation and Placement are not available at this time.
