Why do we need a Transportation Plan?

AB 181 adopted by the State
Legislature last year as part of the
Budget Act

AB 181...

- Provides transportation funding and
 - Requires local school districts to develop transportation plans by April 1 this year and to update them annually.
-

Who needs transportation in Piedmont?

- The District is required to provide transportation to students with special needs, according to their individual education plans (IEPs).
- The District is required to provide transportation to homeless students.
- AB 181 requires the plan to include no-cost transportation for students who are low-income, English learners and foster youth.

How will we provide transportation?

Student Population	Transportation to School
TK-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Walking distance / parent accompaniment
6-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Walking distance / individual cars / AC Transit
English Learner, Low Income (FRLP) or Foster Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Walking distance / individual cars / AC Transit● Free bus pass is made available for student and, if student is in grade TK-5, for guardian, if requested.● Bus service not available to Wildwood; other accommodations can be made.
Homeless Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Free bus pass for student and for guardian, if student in grade TK-5. Bus service not available to Wildwood; other accommodations can be made.
SPED per IEP	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Contracted small vehicle or van, or parent provided transport with reimbursement by District

Funding

The District anticipates receiving approx. 60% of prior year transportation expenditures.
