





DEFINITION

- Instruction in which the student and instructor are in different locations
- Students are under the general supervision of a certificated teacher

INCLUDES

- Online Interaction, instruction and check-ins between between teachers and students
- Print materials incorporating assignments that are the subject of written or oral feedback

INSTRUCTION


- Content aligned grade level standards equal in rigor to in-person
- Daily live interaction with teachers and peers for purposes of instruction, progress monitoring and maintaining school connectedness






POSITION ALONG CONTINUUM CHANGES BASED ON COMMUNITY HEALTH CIRCUMSTANCES








