**RESOLUTION ELECTING TO ADOPT LESS THAN HALFTIME BENEFITS  
UNDER SECTION 22807 OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT  
WITH RESPECT TO A RECOGNIZED EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION  
002 Santa Rosa Teachers' Association (SRTA)**

- WHEREAS, (1) Santa Rosa City Schools is a contracting agency under Government Code Section 22920 and subject to the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act (the "Act") for participation by members of Santa Rosa Teachers' Association (SRTA); and
- WHEREAS, (2) Government Code Section 22807 permits a contracting agency subject to the Act to provide benefits to its less than half-time employees, upon proper application; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, (a) Santa Rosa City Schools desires to obtain for its employees the benefit of Section 22807 and accepts the liabilities and obligations of a contracting agency under the Section; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (b) Santa Rosa City Schools elects to be subject to the provisions of Section 22807 of the Government Code; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (c) Santa Rosa City Schools has fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507 in electing the benefits set forth above; and be it further
- RESOLVED, (d) That the participation of the employees and annuitants of Santa Rosa City Schools shall be subject to determination of its status as an "agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State" that is eligible to participate in a governmental plan within the meaning of Section 414(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, upon publication of final Regulations pursuant to such Section. If it is determined that Santa Rosa City Schools would not qualify as an agency or instrumentality of the state or political subdivision of a State under such final Regulations, the California Public Employees' Retirement System may be obligated, and reserves the right to terminate the health coverage of all participants of the employer; and be it further

RESOLVED, (e) That the executive body appoint and direct, and it does hereby appoint and direct, Rick Edson, Deputy Superintendent to file with the Board a verified copy of this resolution, and to perform on behalf of Santa Rosa City Schools all functions required of it under the Act; and be it further

RESOLVED, (f) That coverage under the Act be effective on July 1, 2021.
