Women in Construction Camp

The Women in Construction Summer Camps will provide a unique week-long, hands-on approach to a construction career to Santa Rosa City Schools girls in grades 11th and 12th.

Students will learn about pathways in construction, construction apprenticeships, safety, teamwork, basic rights and responsibilities of construction workers, and steps for project completion. Upon completion of the camp, each student will earn First Aid Certification, a letter of recommendation from one of the course instructors, and a set of starter construction tools.

The camps are free to participants, but space is limited to 20 students per session, so sign-up today to secure your spot. Registration closes on May 20th.
