MAP also provides district and site leadership to monitor student growth against CCSS and national norms. MAP can be imported into eduCLIMBER so scores can be cross referenced with other data. MAP is also partnered with many other products such as Khan Academy and Newsela to support differentiation.		MAP assessments for grades 7-12 will provide three times a year assessment data that will allow for clear analysis of student academic performance in math and English. It will allow for more data informed decision making at the site, district, and Board of Education level. Shared common assessments are a key part of any educational institution and provide the foundation for professional collaboration around clear indicators about student learning.
