



Small Group Instruction (SGI) Notice to Parents

Parents,

The IEP Team has recommended that your child be enrolled in a course that is more individually appropriate for your child. This class is called Small Group Instruction (SGI). The team wants you to be aware that it is the goal of the Santa Rosa School District that every student has access and is supported to have a 220 college preparation course of study. You have that right. Through the IEP process, your IEP Team must explore accommodations and services that support your child to make those goals.

However, as recommended by the Team, your child may need support in a smaller and more individualized way. This class WILL remove your child from the college preparatory graduation track. However, they remain eligible for a comprehensive SRCS Diploma. The Team is presenting this to you and asking you to consider this to support your child in their learning. You do not have to make this decision today. Please ask any questions of your team and anyone else you may need for this decision.

For your information, the SGI class is:

- An appropriate class for students with disabilities who may be struggling in a particular subject.
- A class that reduces the amount of time in the school day that your child spends with general education students
- A Diploma track class that allows your child full graduation rights and benefits as any California Diploma

The SGI is NOT:

- A class meant to prepare students for college classes, that includes the Junior College
- A class that qualifies students for current or future college scholarships

Our goal is to ensure you are fully aware of your Parents Rights and all of the options available to you in making educational decisions for your child.
