

# Santa Rosa City School Individual Graduation Plan

## **TIER 3**

For students in the Class of 2021 who are not on track to graduate and who could meet California's basic mandated requirements for a high school diploma, an IGP would allow them to drop or add any course that would allow them to meet the state's 130 credits required for a high school diploma. To further support students with a Tier 3 IGP, a bridge course providing transition and life skills will be mandatory for students to receive their diplomas. Students with a tier 3 IGP would participate in all graduation activities before completing this bridge course.

## **TIER 2**

For students in the Class of 2021 who are meeting all requirements to enter a UC or CSU after graduation but are experiencing difficulties with additional classes not required for entrance to a UC/CSU, an IGP would allow them to drop any non-essential classes in semester 2.

## **TIER 1**

All students in the Class of 2021 are being reviewed for and can access an IGP if needed. For students on-track to meeting the current SRCS Graduation requirement of 220 credits and want to keep their schedule as is for semester 2, no alteration of changes to their classes is needed.
