Resolution of the Santa Rosa City School District Requesting a Consolidation Feasibility Study

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Santa Rosa City Schools District, ("District") desires to obtain a comprehensive study to determine the feasibility of consolidation or partial consolidation of the feeder elementary school districts with that of the District; and

WHEREAS, the information obtained through the comprehensive feasibility study will be used to assist the District with determining whether to seek consolidation or partial consolidation pursuant to Education Code sections 35500 *et. seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the District Governing Board desires to have the Sonoma County Superintendent of Schools obtain and pay for the feasibility study on behalf of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Rosa City Schools District, as follows:

- 1. The District Superintendent is directed to request that the Sonoma County Superintendent of Schools obtain and pay for a comprehensive feasibility study in accordance with this resolution.
- 2. The feasibility study shall provide the District Governing Board with all of the information it needs to make a decision to seek consolidation or partial consolidation pursuant to Education Code sections 35500 et. seq., including but not limited to academic, economic, and service benefits to the District.
- 3. Once the feasibility study is completed, a copy shall be provided to the District Governing Board for consideration. The District Governing Board understands this feasibility study, when completed, will be available to the public upon request.
