RESOLUTION #C21-22-2

Resolution of Intent to Initiate a Transition to a By-Trustee Area Election System Commencing with the 2022 Governing Board Election

- **WHEREAS**, the Del Norte County Office of Education's Board of Education ("County board") is currently elected using a "hybrid at-large" election system, meaning that governing board members must live in defined trustee areas, but are elected by voters of the entire county;
- **WHEREAS**, County board members are elected in even-numbered years and serve staggered, four-year terms, such that the next election for three board members is scheduled for November 2022, with the remaining two board members scheduled for election in November 2024;
- **WHEREAS**, under the California Voting Rights Act ("CVRA"), at-large elections are impermissible if they result in racially polarized voting. Racially polarized voting is defined as "voting in which there is a difference . . . in the choice of candidates or other electoral choices that are preferred by voters in a protected class, and in the choice of candidates and electoral choices that are preferred by voters in the rest of the electorate";
- **WHEREAS**, a transition from at-large to "by-trustee area" elections, where each board member must reside within a designated trustee area boundary, and is elected *only by the voters in that trustee area*, minimizes the potential for litigation against the county under the CVRA;
- **WHEREAS**, the County board desires to promote meaningful voter involvement in the election of County board members and increase the ability of candidates to seek elected office;
- **WHEREAS**, the County board intends to begin the process to transition from at-large to by-trustee area elections;
- **WHEREAS**, the County board wishes to proceed with the statutorily required public hearings in a manner that is both efficient and legally sound;
- **WHEREAS**, the County board will hold a minimum of two public hearings prior to developing proposed trustee-area boundary maps;
- **WHEREAS**, upon the release of the 2020 federal decennial census data, the County board will hold a minimum of two additional public hearings to seek public input on the proposed trustee area maps developed with assistance from a demographer;
- **WHEREAS**, the County board will hold an additional public hearing before adopting a trustee-area map and submitting it to the Del Norte County Committee on School District Organization ("County Committee") for consideration;

WHEREAS, California Education Code section 1002 authorizes the County Committee, upon application of the County Board, to change the method of election of the County board from hybrid at-large to by-trustee area;

WHEREAS, the County board also sits as the County Committee, and upon completion of the hearings listed above, intends to hold an additional public hearing sitting as the County Committee, before voting to approve the change in the County board's method of election;

WHEREAS, the adoption of "by-trustee area" elections will not affect the terms of any current County board members serving or elected during this transition, each of whom will have the opportunity to serve out his or her full term;

WHEREAS, County board members also sit as the Del Norte County Unified School District Board of Education ("District board"), meaning any change to the method of election to the County board will result in a corresponding change to the method of election for the District board; and

WHEREAS, the County board acknowledges that the District board will consider a similar resolution to document its agreement or disagreement with the contemplated change to the method of election for the District board.

THEREFORE, the Del Norte County Board of Education hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct;
- 2. The Superintendent and/or designee shall commence the process of transitioning to by-trustee area elections, in full compliance with all appropriate procedures and policies provided in law, including but not limited to Education Code section 1002, and Elections Code sections 10010 and 14025, et seq.;
- 3. The Superintendent, or designee, is hereby directed to prepare additional County board resolutions and documents, as needed, to meet all applicable legal requirements in a timely manner;
- 4. The Superintendent, or designee, shall consult with legal counsel to take all steps necessary to implement and give effect to this resolution; including but not limited to engaging a demographer; and
- 5. The foregoing resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
