

Executive Summary

Bid 17-10: Computer Workstations,
Chromebooks, Laptops/Ultrabooks, Laptop
Carts and Accessories

May 2017

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Purpose

The purpose of solicitation Bid 17-10 is to procure qualified bidders to provide administrative and instructional computer workstations, Chromebooks, laptops, Ultrabooks, charging carts, and

associated services in accordance with the specifications, terms and conditions stated herein the bid requirements. The most responsive bidders will provide a turnkey solution that provides storage, warehousing, delivery, shipping, imaging, engraving, inside delivery, on-site installation, training, activation, configuration/testing, acceptance, all paperwork (barcoding, etc.) and all things necessary for the provision of the specified equipment.

Background and Process

The evaluation team was made up of six Information Technology staff. The representing staff are as follows: Instructional Technology (1), Enterprise Systems (2), Project Management (2) and Technical Support Services (1). The bid was written and submitted for approval in February 2017, was published for two weeks in March 2017, and evaluated in May 2017. The evaluation is based on a set of the components below:

1. Company Performance and Services

- Ability to Execute
- Warranty and Support

2. System Features (per device in each category)

- Premium Desktops
- Basic desktops
- Chromebooks
- Ultrabooks
- Laptops
- Laptop Charging Carts

3. Cost

The criteria used to evaluate the choices and their weights were (in order of importance):

Cost – 40%

Ability to Execute – 25%

System Features – 20%

Warranty and Support – 15%

Of the six (6) proposals that were reviewed for this solicitation, five (5) responses were considered responsive – see list below. Four of the five responses responded to each category mentioned in *#2 System Features* (page 3). Troxell Communications Inc. responded only to the charging cart portion of the bid. The company that was deemed non-responsive Howard Technology Solution.

Virtucom Inc.

Arej Jones Educational Solutions

Unistar-Sparco Computers Inc.

Office Depot Inc.

Troxell Communications Inc.

The team's methodology for making an assessment was to evaluate the *Cost* and the *System Features* separately from the *Company Performance and Services*. *Company Performance and Services* is based on the bidders' ability to execute projects and maintain the devices. *System Features* are based on the technical specifications of the devices, whereas *Cost* is based on the lowest responsive price and technical features. Below highlights the evaluation process (or steps) that the team followed:

1. Created the evaluation matrix
2. Evaluated the Company Performance and Services
3. Evaluated the system features for each device
4. Evaluated the cost

Evaluation Results

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the five (5) bidders could meet the four (4) major criteria, Virtucom appears to be the best choice.

The five (5) bidders considered were:

Virtucom
Arey Jones
Unistar
Office Depot
Troxell

As mentioned earlier, the criteria used to evaluate the choices were:

- Cost
- Ability to Execute
- System Features
- Warranty and Support

1. Decision Process for *Ability to Execute* and *Warranty & Support*

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the 5 bidders could meet two of the four major criteria considered, Virtucom appears to be the best choice.

The significant factors that made Virtucom the most responsive bidder of the five is the *Ability to Execute*.

The decision table below gives a graphical display of the company's performance and services (see

page 3). Virtucom was the most responsive bidder relative to the other companies that responded. Virtucom received a perfect score in Ability to Execute and Warranty and Support. Note: The DecideRight software was used to create the decision table and the summary is calculated on a 10-point scale.

2. Decision Process for System Features and Cost

For each device, a Systems Features and Cost decision table was created. See the displays below and *Appendix I*.

Premium Desktops

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the seven of the eight** devices met the technical specifications, the HP Z640 appears to be the best choice for meeting the system requirements. However, from a cost perspective, the Dell 5040 and HP Pro Desk 400 G4 have the best combination of price and features.

**Note: The eighth device was the Lenovo M715 Tiny which did not meet technical specifications. Therefore, it was eliminated from the list of devices that deemed responsive to the technical requirements. (See Appendix 1 for details, page 14)

Basic Desktops

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the five devices met the technical specifications, the HP 705 SFF appears to be the best choice for meeting the system requirements and cost. See Figures 3 and 4.

Chromebooks

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the five of the six** devices met the technical specifications, the Acer R11 appears to be the best choice for meeting the system requirements and cost. See Figures 5 and 6.

**Note: The sixth device was the Lenovo N23 Yoga which did not meet technical specifications. Therefore, it was eliminated from the list of devices that deemed responsive to the technical requirements. (See Appendix 1 for details, page 14)

Ultrabooks

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the six devices met the technical specifications, the Lenovo ThinkPad 13 appears to be the best choice for meeting the system requirements and cost. See Figures 7 and 8.

Laptops

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the five devices met the technical specifications, the Dell Latitude E5570 appears to be the best choice for meeting the system requirements. However, from a cost perspective, the HP ProBook 655 G3 has the best price point. See Figures 9 and 10.

Charging Carts

Based on a careful evaluation of how well each of the nine charging carts met the technical specifications, the Aver CHRGEE36C appears to be the best choice. However, from a cost perspective, the Bretford TVC32PAC has the best price point. The LocknCharge Joey 30 provides the best benefits for instruction, storage, security, and mobility. The best choice for the district is the LocknCharge Joey 30. See Figures 11 and 12.

Final Recommendation: Virtucom is the best choice in Cost, Company Performance (Ability to Execute and Warranty & Support) and System Features across all product lines.
