Proximity Card Readers

- 19 buildings
 - 10 secondary, 9 elementary
- Columbia Police Department Community Outreach Unit (COU) has fobs
- Working on all police access



DVR Upgrades

- Digital Watchdog
- Replaced all elementary—allows HD over existing cable
- Cost is one-third of previous DVRs—unit cost, \$1,450
- Now have 3 systems instead of 7



Security Film

- 15 buildings, with plans for more this year
- \$73,907 so far
- Mostly exterior, but some interior



Secure Entryway

- Architect is evaluating existing buildings
- Aslin included
- Provide vestibule entry
- All new construction projects include a safety design



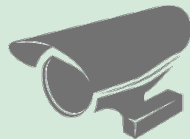

Proximity Card Readers

- Only six buildings remain anticipated completion summer 22-23
- All Columbia Police officers have fob access to all buildings
 - Including hard keys



DVR Upgrades

- Digital Watchdog
- Approximately \$1 Million
- Now have 1 system instead of 7
- Remote access viewing capable



Security Film

- All buildings completed
- \$447,749 currently
- Mostly exterior, but some interior



Building Access

- Buzz in entry
- Architect is evaluating remaining buildings
- Provide single point of entry
- All new construction projects include a safety design
- \$3.5 Million vestibules only
 - Over \$6 Million total
 - 40+ buildings



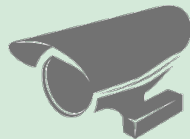
