Board of Education Work Session

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The criteria for determining whether a school should be capped:

- Class size legislation
- When a school will realize capacity loss
- •When core facilities (dining, parking, pedestrian & vehicle traffic, toilets, media, student support, etc.) have been significantly overloaded by enrollment.
- •When a school has used all means of accommodating students, staff, and programs to include sharing and floating educational programs.
- When trailer additions are not available.
- •When attending enrollment reflects and/or base growth projects a significant enrollment beyond capacity, particularly at the entry level grade.



Staff recommends the <u>expiration</u> of the enrollment cap at Apex MS and Enloe HS. Staff recommends that the 4 schools listed below <u>continue</u> their enrollment cap for the 2018-19 school year:
