

## 5300 Grouping For Instruction

Assignment of students to classes is the responsibility of the principal.

### 5300.1

Grouping of students for instruction shall be on the basis of the most desirable combination of a number of important factors. Students who can succeed and maintain a feeling of belonging should be grouped together based upon:

- A. What is best for the individual pupil,
- B. What is best for the group with which she/he is placed,
- C. What is best for effective instruction of the group,
- D. What is best as indicated by grouping criteria established by the Superintendent.

These criteria will be based on the best objective test data and the IEP for identified handicapped students.
