

Policy 3265: Student Owned Electronic Communication

SECTION 1. USE OF STUDENT-OWNED ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- 1.1 Students, with the permission of their parent(s)/guardian(s), or the student themselves, if over 18 years of age, may be in possession of personal electronic device laptops, tablets, e-readers, or other related electronic devices on school property. The devices shall not be used in a manner that disrupts the educational process, inc or violating confidentiality or privacy rights of another individual. Unless an emergency situation exists that involves imminent physical danger or a certified District em class), use of devices shall be limited to:
- The period before classes begin in the morning;
 - During the student's lunch period; and
 - After the student's last class in the afternoon.
- 1.2 Access to the device is a privilege and not a right. Each student will be required to follow the Acceptable Use of Electronic Networks Policy and the Internet Acc
- 1.3 Students may only access the internet through the filtered District connection, regardless of whether they are using their personal device or a District-issued dev assistance for student-owned devices.
- 1.4 Because power cords stretched out in classrooms become a safety issue both for the students and devices, charging the device in any classroom, hallway, or any allowed.
- 1.5 The use of cameras in any type of electronic device is strictly prohibited in locker rooms, restrooms, and classrooms unless a certified District employee authorizes electronic devices, they are required to obtain permission before taking a photograph or video of any individual. Students must also obtain permission from any indivi social networking site or other internet site.
- 1.6 Students found to be using any electronic communications device to send or receive personal messages, data, or information in any way that would contribute to assignment shall be subject to discipline and the device shall be confiscated and not returned until a parent conference has been held.
- 1.7 Students are responsible for safeguarding devices they bring to school. The District shall not be responsible for loss, theft, damages, or destruction of student ow
- 1.8 Students shall comply with any additional rules developed by the school concerning appropriate use of telecommunication or other electronic devices. Students action, including losing the privilege of bringing the device onto school property, detention, suspension, or expulsion. In addition, an administrator will confiscate the parent(s)/guardian(s). Where appropriate, police authorities may be contacted.
- 1.9 The controls on electronic communication devices contained in this policy do not apply to special education or Section 504 students or students with an Individu plans conflict with uses outlined herein.
