

Policy 3610: Records of Missing Children

Status: DRAFT

Original Adopted Date: Pending

1. Upon notification by the Idaho State Police of a missing or runaway child currently enrolled in the District, the student's records shall be flagged in such a manner that whenever a copy of or information regarding the record is requested, the school is alerted to the fact that the record is that of a missing or runaway child. If a request is made for a flagged record, the record shall not be forwarded and the local law enforcement agency shall be notified of the request for the flagged record.
2. Any request concerning flagged records or knowledge as to the whereabouts of a missing or runaway child shall immediately be reported to the local law enforcement agency. Upon notification by the Idaho State Police of the return of a missing or runaway child, the school shall remove the flag from the student's record.
