

Policy 7500: New Fees or Increase of Fees

1. The Superintendent/Designee shall review the annual fees assessed to determine if an increase, decrease, new fee, or other change is necessary. The Superintendent/Designee shall report the fee findings to the Board at least annually.
2. In the event a fee increase of less than 5% from the prior fee amount is necessary, the Board can review and vote on such a fee increase. However, in the event a fee increase of five-percent (5%) or more from the prior fee amount is necessary, the Board shall hold a hearing upon such a proposed fee increase at a regular or special meeting of the Board.
3. The Board shall provide notice of the meeting according to Idaho Code § 63-1311A. Meeting notice shall include the reason for the meeting, (i.e. the Board is considering a fee increase that is in excess of five percent (5%) of the amount of fees last collected prior to such decision). If the Board is considering assessing a new fee, the meeting notice shall indicate such.
