## EARLY ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT GRID

A series of social and academic assessments will be utilized to determine whether or not your child is fully prepared for early entrance to kindergarten/first grade. A child who meets four of the following five criteria will be considered a successful early entrance candidate. The child must turn five by $9 / 30$ to be considered for 5 K or six by $9 / 30$ to be considered for $1^{\text {st }}$ grade as verified by a birth certificate.
