

EARLY ENTRANCE ASSESSMENT GRID

A series of social and academic assessments will be utilized to determine whether or not your child is fully prepared for early entrance to kindergarten/first grade. A child who meets four of the following five criteria will be considered a successful early entrance candidate. The child must turn five by 9/30 to be considered for 5K or six by 9/30 to be considered for 1st grade as verified by a birth certificate.
